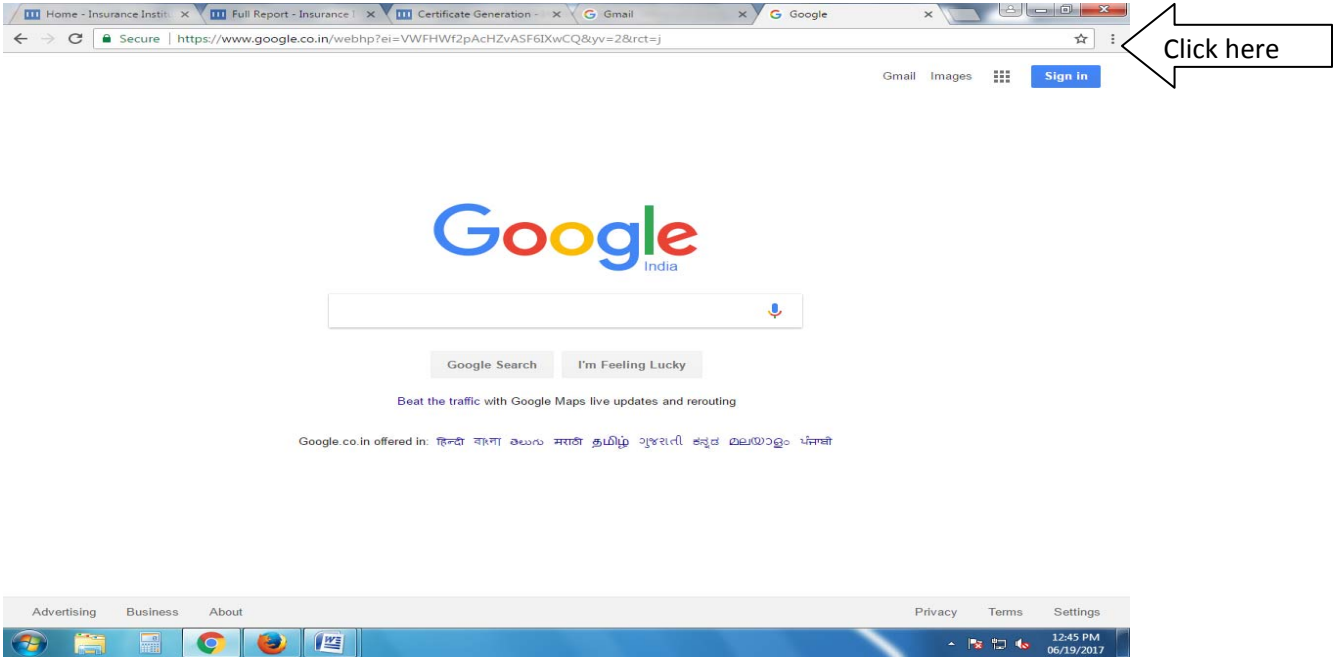
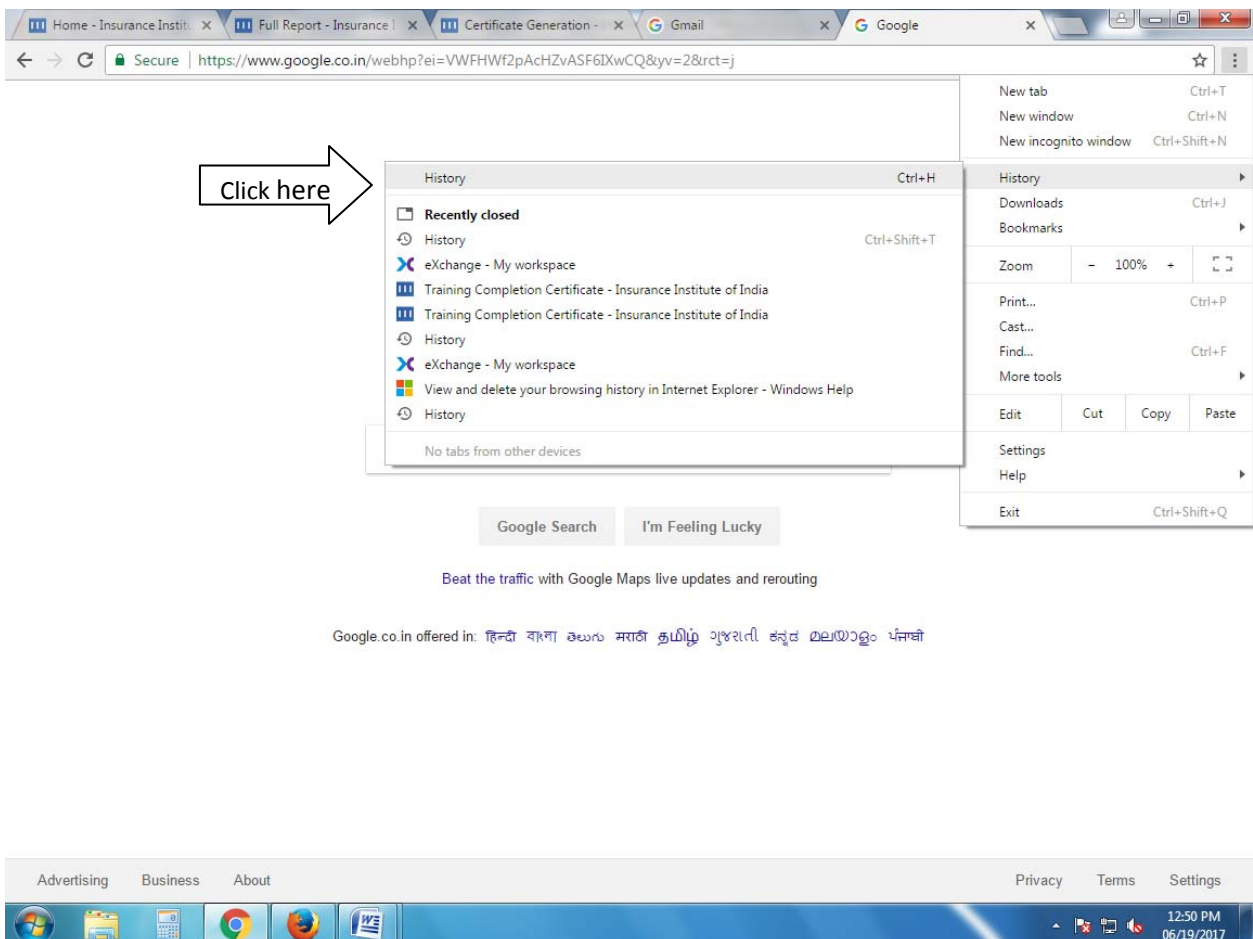


How to clear History, Cookies, Cache of Google Chrome

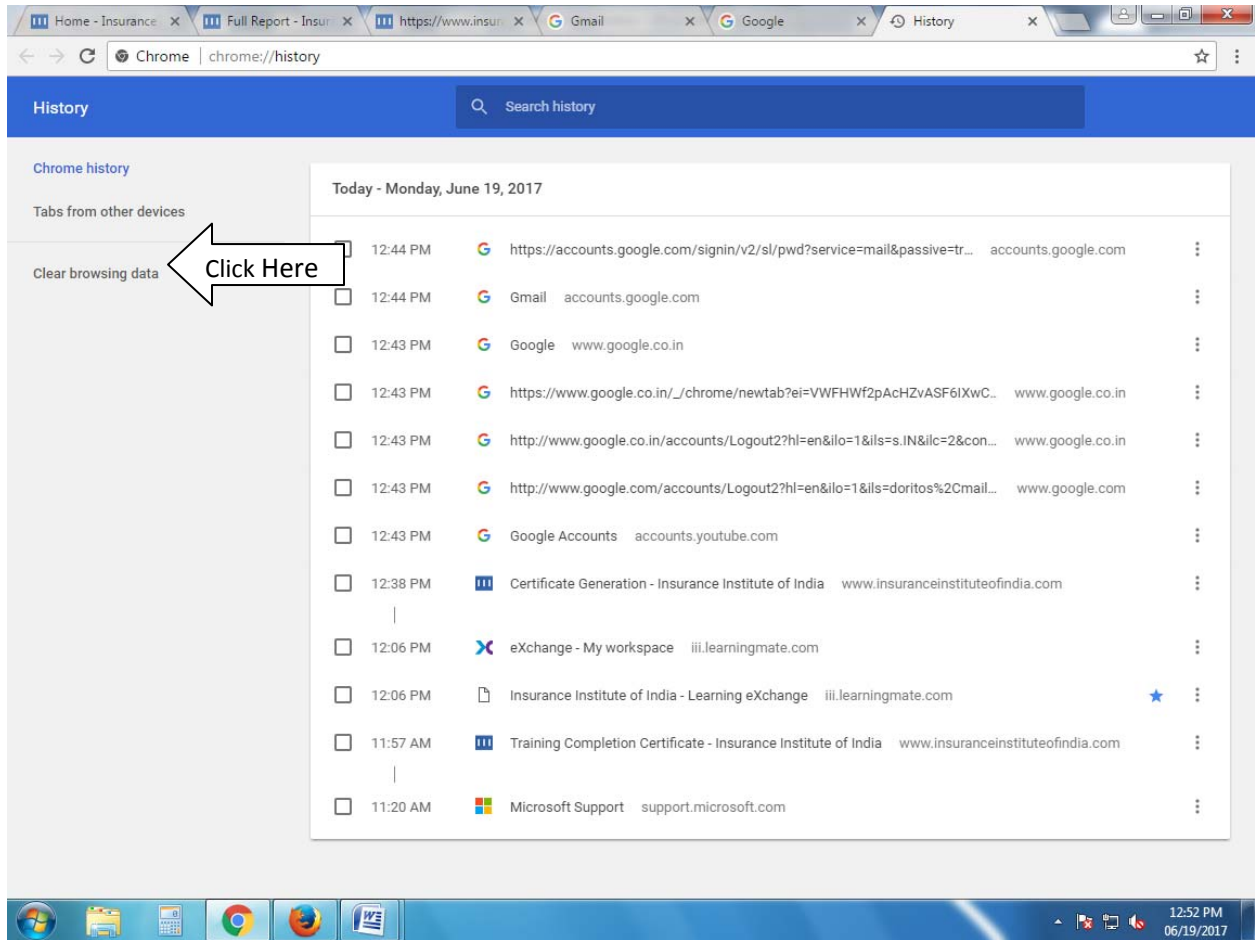
1) Open Google Chrome
